

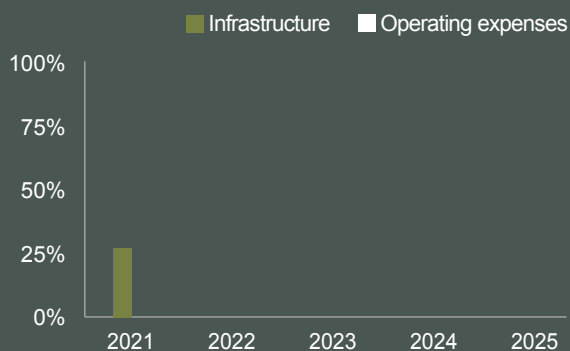


# NEPAL III

## DECEMBER 2021 REPORT

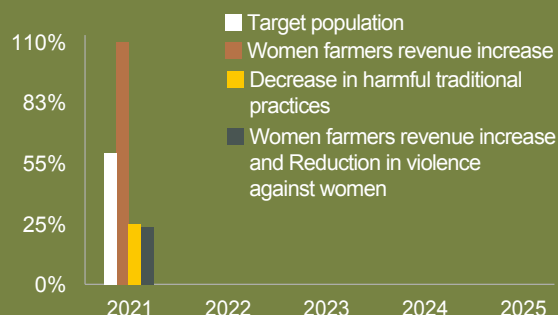
The purpose of this project is about providing essential skills to marginalized women and adolescent girls. More specifically, it consists in training them on 2 aspects: (i) Empowerment, i.e. women’s leadership development (gender relation, self-awareness, leadership and accountability, negotiation and conflict management, and (ii) financial autonomy, i.e. sustainable and improved livestock farming and agriculture, business plan development, marketing and sales, together with climate change adaptation.

### Expected impact:

- 1 Target population: 8.826 people
- 2 Women’s revenue increase: 100%
- 3 Reduction in violence against women: 20%
- 4 Decrease in harmful traditional practices

While in its launch phase, the local partner NGO has conducted all the planned activities and reached out to the targeted group of people. It has managed to implement activities that will over time have a catalytic impact on the future of the population. However, the coronavirus pandemic has exacerbated inequalities due to gender differences and social norms, and disproportionately impacted women with wide-ranging effects on livelihood, education, gender-based violence, and unpaid care work. This renders our action even more relevant.
