

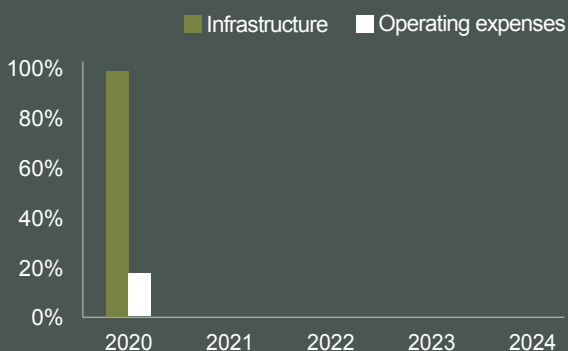


CUBA

DECEMBER 2020 REPORT

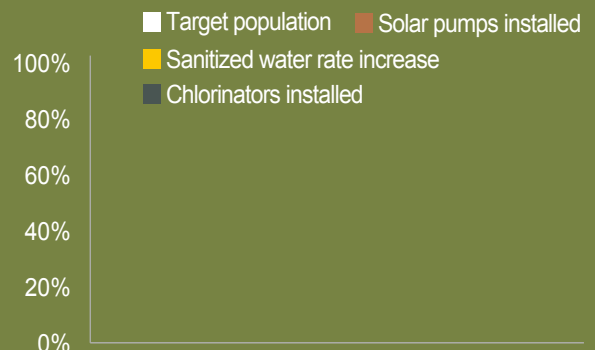
This project consists in installation of photovoltaic chlorinators fitted with all the necessary infrastructure works to ensure the supply of drinking water to the population from different remote communities of the Báguanos municipality, east of the island. In addition, 6 photovoltaic energy pump systems will be installed in 4 communities to provide additional supply for more than 500 people.

Donation:

- 1 Donation: €40.000 by the Mangrove Foundation
- 2 €94.816 co-financing by Luxembourg Ministry of European and Foreign Affaires



Expected impact:

- 1 Target population: 7.700 people
- 2 Chlorinators installed: 13
- 3 Solar pumps installed: 6
- 4 Sanitized water rate increase: 20%

Though recently initiated, the projects faced the inevitable delays caused by the pandemic, added to the hassle resulting from the US embargo on Cuba. The equipment was purchased and shipped and is pending import. In the meantime, the field preparatory work is perfectly on schedule.
